## SNOW REMOVAL

As the vast majority of residents are seasonal, the Resort Village of Etters Beach does not at this time provide full-time services and will not be directing funding to all-season utilities or routine snow removal.

If medical/fire emergencies should occur, snow removal will be contracted by the Village.

Any residents or contractors clearing snow in the Resort Village should be knowledgeable regarding their liability and risk and ensure that they conform to all provincial and federal legislation which may include, but is not restricted to, the following:

- 1) The Vehicles Equipment Regulations, 1987
- 2) Occupational Health and Safety Regulations, 1996
- 3) Vehicle has to be equipped with:
  - a) Amber or Amber and Blue Beacons (The Vehicle Administration Act and Regulations)\*\*Please note that hazard lamps or warning lights on a tractor **ARE NOT BEACONS.**
  - b) Working Headlights
  - c) Slow-moving signage
  - d) Roll-over protective devices and seat belts
  - e) A clear and unobstructed windshield
  - f) Working wiper blades
- 4) Operator needs a valid Saskatchewan Driver's License
