

RESORT VILLAGE OF ETTER'S BEACH

Bylaw No. 10 of 1997

A BYLAW TO REGULATE AND PROHIBIT THE DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS

The Council of the Resort Village of Etter's Beach in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. For the purpose of this bylaw, the expression "municipality" shall mean the Resort Village of Etter's Beach.
2. Subject to section 3, no person shall discharge any gun or other firearms, air-gun or spring gun or any class or type thereof within the municipality.
3. The provisions of section 2 do not apply to a person who is:
 - (a) a police officer;
 - (b) a conservation officer; or
 - (c) a member of the municipal council authorized to exterminate a wild animal or pest at large within the Resort Village of Etter's Beach.
4. A person who contravenes the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offense and upon summary conviction shall be liable to the penalty provided for by the general penalty bylaw of the municipality.
5. Bylaw Number 1, passed May 23, 1966, is hereby repealed.
