

# Etters Beach Recreation Site

## SEASONAL CAMPING GENERAL INFORMATION, CONDITIONS AND REGULATIONS

1. **SEASON** **Seasonal** campsites are available from **May 1, 2022 to September 30, 2022** (there will be **no guarantee of water/shower accessibility before May 15<sup>th</sup>**)
2. **GENERAL CONDITIONS**

Due to the nature of seasonal camping and the pressure continual use places on our natural features and park infrastructure, conditions for seasonal campers are more stringent than conditions that apply to short-term campers within the Etters Beach Recreation Site. The following conditions have been separated into two categories, those that apply to SEASONAL campers only and those that apply to ALL campers (including seasonal).

Possible exceptions or considerations may be discussed with the Recreation Site Administration Office.

### **SEASONAL CAMPERS ONLY**

- a) Seasonal dates are May 1 – Sept. 30. Campground services may be reduced prior to Victoria Day and after the Labour Day weekend. We **do NOT** guarantee water/showers before May 15<sup>th</sup> of any given year.
- b) Lights are restricted to a maximum of 12 patio lights (1 string) or 1 section of rope lights per site. All lights must be CSA approved.
- c) Seasonal Campers may construct quality type decking up to 100 square feet and may place Temporary Storage systems up to 10ft X10ft – each of which must be sufficiently anchored to prevent event damages.
- d) Major appliances are restricted to **those fixed in the camping unit**/contained within the original unit's construction.
- e) Campers shall not rent, sell, sublet, assign or otherwise transfer the assigned site.
- f) All camping units must be movable upon 24 hours notice. *Seasonal Campers may store their watercraft at our Storage Area at no charge during the summer months.*
- g) Failure to comply with these conditions and Parks Act and Regulations may result in eviction and/or loss of the campsite for the season.
- h) The Recreation Site administration office is to be notified if the camping unit is to be removed from the seasonal site for any time period. The Recreation Site reserves the right to assign the campsite to another camper for the vacated period. Notice of 24 hours is required when returning to a seasonal site.
- i) At the end of the camping season, RVs are to be removed from the site. RV's, boats, etc. can be stored at the Storage Area over the Winter months for \$175.00 per year.
- j) **As of September 2017, seasonal campers are in fact allowed to leave tent frames and decks on their seasonal sites through the winter months.**

## ALL CAMPERS

- a) Campers shall maintain the camping site and camping unit in an acceptable condition.
- b) Only **one** camping unit (tent, tent-trailer, camper, camper-truck/van, camping trailer, or motorhome) is allowed **per campsite**. Mobile homes and bunkhouse type trailers are not allowed. All units/sites must be maintained so as not to detract from the park setting. Due to campsite size, length restrictions may apply. All units/equipment must be contained within the sites.
- c) One small tent per single site for accommodating dependent children and one screened tent for meal purposes is allowed depending on the size of the campsite.
- d) Grey water/sewage must be contained and disposed of at disposal sites. Disposal of grey water/sewage on the ground is prohibited.
- e) Fires are allowed in provided fireplace/barbeques. Propane or other non-wood burning portable barbeques are acceptable for cooking purposes. During extreme conditions, bans on fires may apply.
- f) Removable ground level landings to a maximum of 80 sq. ft. (7.43 m. sq.) will be allowed.
- g) The Recreation Site determines the use of power plants/generators in campgrounds. The Recreation Site may restrict hours of use as required.
- h) Any combination of tarps may not exceed 400 sq. ft. (37.16 m. sq.). Tarps cannot be used vertically.
- i) All camping units and vehicles, other than tents and truck campers, must be legally registered and display a current, valid license plate at all times when on recreation site lands.
- j) All vehicles must be licensed and kept on roadways and parking lots. Only two vehicles are allowed at each campsite at any time. One (1) watercraft per site is allowed. Visitors are to park their vehicles in designated visitor parking areas where available.
- k) The camper, their family and guests shall comply at all times with all camping conditions and regulations. The camper is responsible for the conduct and behaviour of their family and guests. Everyone must observe all campground regulations and conditions. Rowdiness or excessive noise is not permitted at any time.
- l) Pets must be kept leashed and attended at all times. Pet owners must ensure that pet litter is cleaned up. Please be considerate of your neighbours.
- m) Alcoholic beverages may be consumed in the camper's camping unit, and on their assigned site, in accordance with *The Alcohol and Gaming Regulations Act*, as per section 108 (1). **The annual alcohol/cannabis ban legislated by the Province of Saskatchewan for the May long weekend is in effect and enforced at the Etters Beach Recreation Site.**
- n) Failure to comply with the above conditions and Parks Act and Regulations may result in eviction.
